

My911 – A Life Saving App Finally Introduced For Google Android Smartphones

My911 Inc. – In the frenzy of new, entertaining Apps for Smartphones, the My911 Company has introduced an App designed to save lives and warn its users when they are potentially in harms way.

The My911 App is OnStar-like capability but on the SmartPhone. The App utilizes the accelerometer to detect if there has been an impact, whether it be in an automobile, motorbike, bicycle, backpacking or on the ice, which triggers an automatic e911 call for help if the person is not able to call for themselves. This rescue feature protects the user wherever they are so long as they have their SmartPhone with them.

“The Company has just released the My911 App for the Google Android line of Smartphones. This is in addition to the service now available for the RIM Blackberry Smartphones, too. The plan is to have the service on all platforms by well before the end of year,” said Larry Hurwitz, CEO and founder of My911.

The App will also provide My Medivac transport services within the USA; worldwide search and rescue; MySOS for notifying family and friends the minute the phone has called out for e911 help along with the location; MyRoadside Assistance that brings help to a vehicle anywhere in the world; MyPredator Alert if the person is in the locale of a known sex offender; and MyCyber Alert if there is an unwanted caller. Finally, the App even posts a \$10k reward, backed by Lloyds of London, if it is confirmed that the person has been abducted or kidnapped.

This App was designed to bring emergency services to the SmartPhone owner even when they cannot call out themselves. It is not limited to a car but provides the service wherever they are located. It is designed to warn the user when they are in harms way. It provides a nurse hotline when someone just has a medical question.

“Because of GPS; SmartPhones; and global underwriters, My911 is changing the world of how a SmartPhone can protect its owner. It is like having a 24/7 guardian watching over you,” said John Knab, Chairman of My911.

The My911 App is downloaded to the SmartPhone for a modest monthly subscription. It may be the most powerful App in the industry for a person’s safety and protection.
